MINIER CITIZEN'S VIEW PROGRAM

CITIZEN'S VIEW is the Minier Police Department's newest crime prevention and investigative program, which partners with residents and businesses to help solve crime and keep our community safe.

Registering your business or personal surveillance camera may help deter crime and assist the Police Department in its overall crime prevention strategy. Help the Minier Police protect your community by registering your surveillance cameras with the CITIZEN'S VIEW program. Registration is fast and simple.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The Minier Police Department is committed to our partnership with residents and business owners. Many business owners and residents currently operate surveillance systems at their businesses and/or homes. As crimes occur nearby, they are not always aware that their system may have captured information that could help solve the crime, thus keeping our community safer. In turn, the police are also not always aware who may have this potentially vital information.

The Minier Police Department is asking residents and businesses across the village to register their privately owned surveillance camera systems. As the Police Department responds to criminal incidents in our community, they may be able to use the information or footage gathered from the security cameras to assist in the apprehension and prosecution of the criminals involved.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF REGISTERING YOUR CAMERA?

CITIZEN'S VIEW will help the police department to quickly identify nearby cameras that may have captured criminal activity. After registering your camera, you would only be contacted by the Minier Police Department if there is a criminal incident in the vicinity of your security camera. Police personnel, if necessary, may request to view your camera footage in order to assist in the investigation. Make Minier an undesirable place for criminals to commit crime and help keep your entire community safe!

REGISTER NOW

Registration

Filling out the registration form is simple. We ask you to provide basic information regarding the location and direction of your cameras.

Verification

Once you have completed the registration process you will be entered into a police database. A member of the Minier Police Department will contact you to confirm the information is accurate.

Call for Assistance

If registered, you would only be contacted by an officer if there is criminal activity in the vicinity of your camera. If necessary, police personnel may request a copy of video captured by your camera to assist in the investigation.

KEEP YOUR COMMUNITY SAFE!

If your residence or business has a security camera system, you can help the police investigate and solve crimes by registering your security camera in one of three ways:

- Print out the <u>CITIZEN'S VIEW registration form</u>, complete it and drop it off at the Village Clerks Office or mail it in to:
